VOTE! ELECTION DAY IS NEAR

California Moves Up 2020 Primary Election to March 3, 2020 and Announces New Voting Centers



This new year brings new changes to when and how we vote. In previous election cycles, the California Primary Election would take place in the month of June. It is important to note that the California 2020 Primary Election is scheduled for March 3, 2020 to coincide with the City's general municipal election.

This change took place in 2017 when then Governor Jerry Brown signed a bill into law moving our primary election three months ahead, consolidating Federal, State and Local elections under one election ballot.

NEW VOTING SYSTEM. Additionally, the Los Angeles County Registrar/ Recorder's Office—who is the administrative government agency that handles our elections—is rolling out a new voting system, changing the way we vote.

The County will be switching to a new electronic system that will make voting available ten days before Election Day. The new ballot will use a touchscreen device and keypad to make voting faster and more accessible with different language options. In addition, new voting centers will appear in Los Angeles County.

It's Important for our Community to Count and Vote

Measure SG is a San Gabriel ballot initiative for a sales-tax increase to fund public infrastructure and public safety services.

San Gabriel's City Council recognizes a pressing need to maintain and enhance public safety services and to invest in the City's infrastructure.

To address these needs, the City Council has voted to place a 0.75% sales tax measure on the March 3, 2020 ballot.

The measure is anticipated to raise \$3 million per year for the City's General Fund, allowing the City to continue to provide vital services to its residents.

What is Measure SG?

Measure SG is a 3/4% proposed increase to the Local Sales Tax. It's an investment in our city.

How Measure SG Works

The 3/4% sales tax is anticipated to raise \$3 million new dollars for San Gabriel services. That's less than a penny on every dollar spent; or just 3 cents more for your cup of coffee.

What We Get

The money will go directly to the City of San Gabriel for 911 emergency response services, public safety, parks and free-after school programs as well as improvements to roads and local infrastructure.
